## How's it going?

On behalf of Linden Homes, Smarter Travel Ltd would like to thank the residents of All Angels Park for their continued engagement during the Travel Plan period, including participation in the Travel Surveys to understand how travel behaviour changes over time, and how we might be able to help you travel more sustainably in future.



We always offer a prize draw in the Travel Surveys, look out for next years' survey in Springtime, we'll be giving away more goodies, such as a £200 shopping voucher and cycle helmet!

We're pleased to share that the All Angels Park Travel Plan is achieving the Year 3 (2026) target of a 6% reduction in vehicle trips to/from the development ahead of schedule. This year, we observed a 20% reduction in the AM Peak (8am-9am) and 47% decrease in the PM Peak (5pm-6pm).

## Active Travel



Find your sense of adventure with [Strava.com](https://strava.com) by following family, friends, even athletes' adventures, log over 30 activities on the app, such as walking and cycling, and have fun with new challenges to keep you motivated.

If you are walking, wheeling or cycling, plan ahead with the [BBC Weather](https://www.bbc.com/weather) app to check if you'll need to grab a coat, brolly or boots.

Your local cycle shop is **Outspoken Cycles**, a 33-minute cycle from home. They offer a range of bikes and accessories as well as adult and children cycle training sessions. Uni of Cambridge staff/students can claim a free cycle training session.



Explore with the **Cambridge Ramblers** group and find local walking routes and group walking events in and around Cambridgeshire.


## Public Transport

The closest bus stops to All Angels Park are Highfields Road on St Neots Road, an 8-min walk from home, for Stagecoach service 4 between Cambridge City Centre - Cambourne, approx. every 20-mins Monday - Saturday and hourly on Sundays and Public Holidays. For timetables and travel updates visit [stagecoachbus.com](https://stagecoachbus.com)

**Cambridge Train Station** is around a 42-min cycle from home, with 2,850 cycle storage spaces available, alternatively you could get the bus which takes around 50-mins or drive, taking approx. 31-mins (excluding traffic and parking). The station has step-free access to all platforms (7 & 8 via lifts). # Travel Plan Perks

## Has your household claimed a welcome voucher yet?

The first occupier of each household within All Angels Park is eligible to claim a £50 active travel voucher or 2-weeks' worth of bus travel with Stagecoach.

Only 35% of occupied households have claimed so far, we wouldn't want you to miss out!
