Public Transport

Jessup Road bus stops are your closest stops approx. 1 min walk from the site entrance on Thetford Road, for Konectbus services 81 (Watton-Thetford), 82 (Watton-Attleborough) & X6 (Norwich-Watton). Catch regular Konectbus services from Crown bus stops on Norwich Road between Watton-Norwich (3/3B/3C/6), Swaffham-Dereham (11/11A), Visit **Konectbus.co.uk** for timetables and tickets.

Traveling further? You can use Attleborough Train Station which is a 43-min bus ride, for links to Norwich, Cambridge, London and more. Cycling? Leave your bike in 1 of the 18 cycle storage spaces or take your bike with you on the train, go to **NationalRail.co.uk/Plusbike**.

Transport Plus provides transport to health appointments and social activities for those who are unable to use public transport. Call **0344 800 8020** to enquire, Mon-Fri, 9am-5pm. Costs £0.45p per mile (cash).
